

Senate Presidential Goals 2019-20

- 1) BAM and Funding Formula reconstruction
 - a. Work with college and district committees towards a more effective allocation model
 - b. Need a strong second on FFC – maybe Craig?
 - c. Need a shadow in PBC and FFC
 - d. Need a data cleanup – make sure we are accurately reporting and accurately receiving all metric points possible
- 2) FFC Requests, Funding and Implementation
 - a. Work with district and college committees to identify priority needs while maintaining necessary reserves
 - b. Need a strong second on FFC – maybe Craig?
 - c. Need a shadow in PBC and FFC
- 3) Faculty Diversification (statewide goal)
 - a. LPC has improved significantly since 2000, yet still has not done as well as Chabot in creating a full time faculty population more representative of its student body (see attached document)
 - b. Both colleges struggle with diversification with part time faculty – this will take some serious MOU action with the union as their actions affect the retention of part time faculty
- 4) Guided Pathways Goals
 - a. Work towards better paths not just for individual disciplines, but across discipline lines – we all use each other not only for gen ed, but also for requirements for ADTs
 - b. Collaborate with CEMC re: Strategic Scheduling
- 5) AB705 Outcomes
 - a. And away we go.....
 - b. We will probably need a senate task force to work with admins in both instruction and student services to evaluate this process
- 6) Brown Act/ Roberts Rules Orientation
 - a. Training, Standardization, and AB2257 Compliance
 - b. Chancellor is thinking of having a chairs training for all committees appearing in board policies
- 7) Explore a “District Plenary”
 - a. Effective communication in multi-college districts
 - b. Ways of finding common ground with Chabot senate/faculty
 - c. This would include both workshops and resolution proposals
