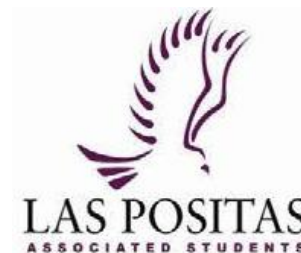

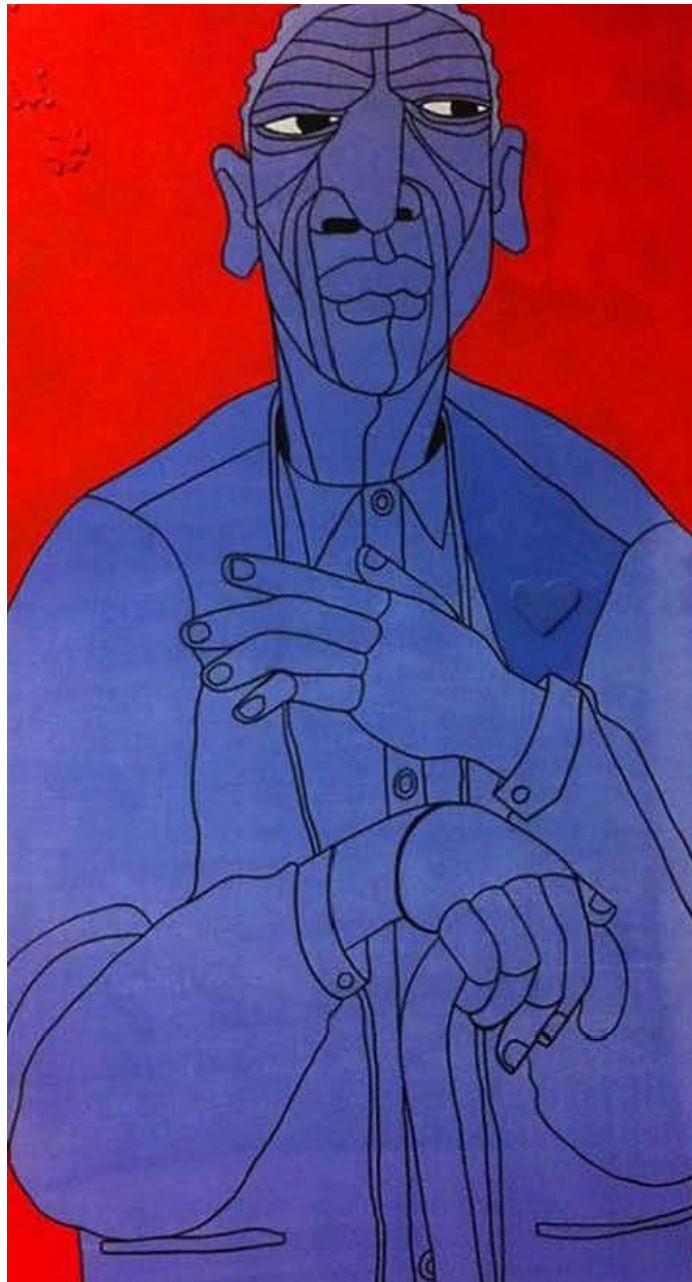

Governor's Budget 2019-20

Governor Newsom's first budget is very positive

- Based on a rosy economic outlook that could change
- Significant additions made to reserves and rainy day fund
- Many proposals are one-time to recognize potential risks

Help for Students and Communities

Governor's budget provides funding for:

- Increasing early childhood education
- Medi-Cal eligibility for young adults age 19-25 regardless of immigration status
- Increased CalWORKs payments
- Additional programs to help address homelessness, promote mental health training and “green economy” job training

Funding for Community Colleges

- COLA of 3.46%
- Includes COLA on some programs like Adult Education, DSPS, EOPS and CalWORKs
- New Cal Grants for parents with dependent children
- Increases to other Cal Grant awards
- Direct payment to CalSTRS to reduce districts' payment obligations (slows the rate of increase)

Student Centered Funding Formula

- Changes made to initial plan to phase in percentage of formula based on student success metrics.
- Recognizes that data discrepancies have created difficulties in implementing the formula as originally planned.
- No impact on our district for now as we are under the “hold harmless” provision.
- Another change that could impact us in future years is the imposition of a 10% cap on year-to-year increases in student success metrics.

Overall a Very Positive Budget for Colleges

Next steps:

- Legislative hearings throughout the spring
- May Revision after income tax revenue is known
- Conference committee made of Senate and Assembly members finalizes budget by June 15 to send to Governor
- Governor signs by June 30

Impact on LPC Budget

- COLA will be added to our base budget, but things are still tight.
- Reserves were used to balance the budget last year and we may need to use the same strategy again.
- We can not make new, long-term funding commitments now, as our “hold harmless” status will end in 2021-22.
- We are working on many fronts to position ourselves for the time we are subject to the new funding formula in two years.

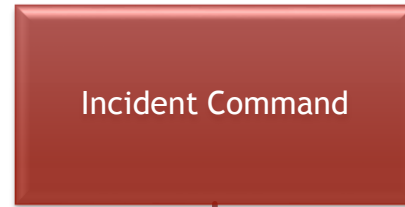

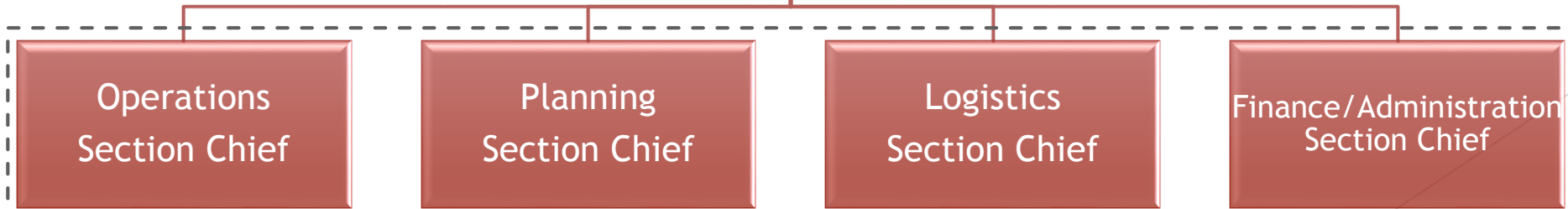

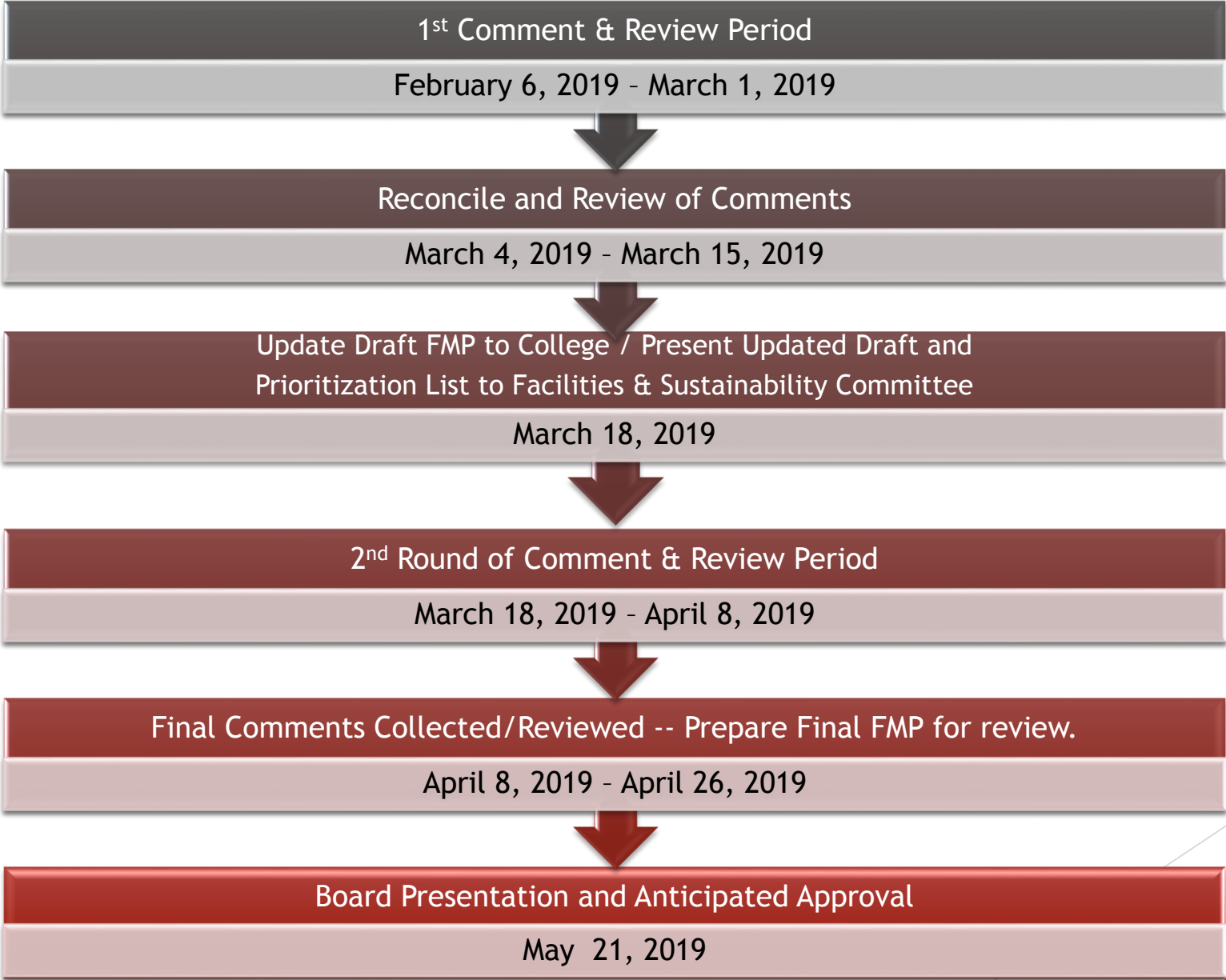
