### District Leadership: Plan Kickoff and Visioning Session Meeting Summary

Meeting: October 30, 2017

Location: CLPCCD District Offices

Description: The District Leadership Meeting served as the kickoff meeting for the 2018 Facilities Master Plan for CLPCCCD. This summary captures the major points made by attendees during the meeting.

### Overall Plan Objectives:

- Supporting students and faculty
- Respond to those who voted for the bond and are part of the institutional community, specially students and faculty so that their voices are heard
- Should consider the program needs that were already discussed in the last bond measure
- Campuses should be safe, fun and welcoming
- Respond to employers' needs. Targeting job industries by understanding the demands from the market
- Support programs unique to college
- Supporting our community synergies
- Technology rich campus with better WIFI/data access inside and outside of the campus
- State of the art facility
- Move with urgency and avoid losing purchasing power/cost escalation
- Improving utility and campus infrastructure like HVAC and have improved back up facilities
- Develop campus identity
- Building relationships and legacy
- Better functional spaces addressing both study and social environments
- Better Transition into the future campus for e.g. Bio Science building
- Green campus with design of sustainable landscape
- Guided pathways with better signage system

- Flexibility in design with modularity
- Integrate student unions in the design process
- Strategic planning considering the future

## Detail design components:

- Upgrading the campus to LEED Silver accreditation
- ADA Compliant
- Better landscape

- Smart classrooms with smart boards
- Better lighting facilities

- Better sidewalk amenities for pedestrians with wider sidewalks
- Need more parking spaces
- Better transit facilities with improved bus stops

## Chabot College:

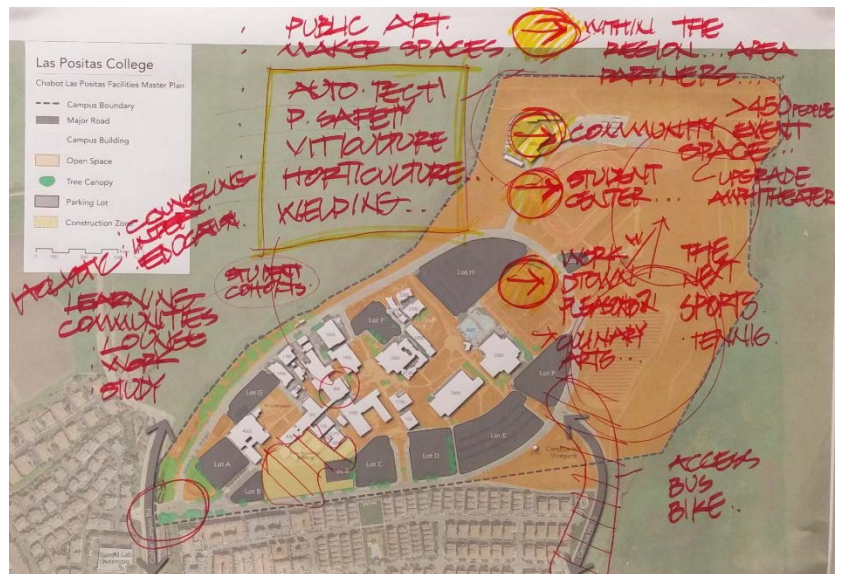
- New buildings - Center for Sustainability
- New buildings - Center for Civic Engagement
- Need for community event spaces
- Bigger student gathering spaces
- Better sports facilities like improving football ground with bleachers and lighting



- Space for community gardens
- Space for modern urban agriculture
- New Art and Science building
- Better transit connections from Hesperian Boulevard
- Hesperian Boulevard too wide with heavy traffic circulation
- Better biking facilities with new bike lanes with space for bike parking
- Sensitive neighbors along the North-Western boundary
- Joint Development opportunities e.g. fire technology
- Double check quality control and assurance
- Combine uses in separate, less functional buildings into new buildings, create synergies

## Las Positas College:

- Desire for installation of public art
- Maker spaces
- Learning community spaces for more than 450 people such as lounges, work and study areas
- Holistic campus buildings - with counselling rooms, interaction spaces and educational training rooms
- New buildings for – Auto Technology, Welding, Public Health, Horticulture, Culinary Arts
- Work with Downtown Pleasanton to improve Collier Canyon Road configuration to provide better entrance to the campus
- Better student center
- Upgrade amphitheater
- Better tennis courts with facilities? Look at future of athletic facilities
- Improve pedestrian amenities
- Better bike infrastructure with Bike lanes
- Improved transit facilities
