Conduct research on select topics involving nuclear weapons and waste issues related to public health and the environment. 3. Complete memoranda, articles, reports and other written materials as needed
- *Additional functions:* Working with staff and other agencies to perform research, analysis, writing and public education duties on select nuclear weapons and waste topics in support of the organization's program goals including (1) Organizing and advocating for sick atomic workers at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL), (2) Research, organizing and public education on Radiation, Toxics and Health Issues, (3) Forcing the Dept. of Energy to clean up contaminated soil and groundwater in Livermore, (4) Safeguarding the community from future contamination, and (5) Enhancing public participation in decision-making on nuclear weapons issues

- Desire to develop strong environmental advocacy skills
- Some knowledge of, and concern for nuclear issues.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, both oral and written.
