Job Description:

- Assigned tasks are tailored with an eye toward fulfilling internship credit requirements. The intern's personal areas of interest and study are taken into consideration when assigning tasks and work.

Gain Experience:

- Coalition Building - Network, phone bank and help mobilize groups and individuals to the Hiroshima event
- Media - Basic skills in working with media (print, TV and radio) to cover large events.
- Event Logistics - General understanding of logistics required to put on a large scale event
- Outreach and Organizing - for peace disarmament and to stop the local environmental and health impacts of nuclear weapons activities in the Bay area
- Nuclear Weapons Issues - Learn broadly about nuclear weapons, disarmament and gain in depth knowledge on nuclear weapons program, and more...

Duration: 2-3 months

Hours: Range from 12-32 hours/week (flexible schedules) Students are required to work at least one day a week in Livermore (either Wed or Thurs) and attend coalition meeting in Oakland.

Pay/Credit: Unpaid, though some transportation stipends are available. Credit for many majors can be arranged. Work study forms must be provided by the intern if applicable.
