Hi Joel,

Hope all is well. I want to make sure that we are on the same page. The 10% number that I gave is typically for the fall and spring semesters.

Here are the online only percentages for the last five semesters (the denominator contains the total number of students at LPC):

Summer 2015: $1,089/3,366 = 32.4\%$

Fall 2015: $926/9,208 = 10.1\%$

Spring 2016: $860/8,993 = 9.6\%$ (the 867 number I gave before was preliminary)

Summer 2016: $1,229/3,655 = 33.6\%$

Preliminary - Fall 2016: $909/9,068 = 10.0\%$

This is great news! Congrats on the decision to use Cranium Café for our online students. During 2015-16, we had a total enrollment of 7,903 students in classes delivered 100% online. However, I do not have access to the figure for unduplicated students. Perhaps Rajinder can get you that figure. I am including him on this reply.

Here's what I have for the past 5 years. I've included DE hybrid courses (51% or more online) if you are interested. I did not include non-DE hybrids (less than 51% online).

Hello,

The counseling faculty had a live demonstration of the Cranium Cafe this afternoon and were very impressed. Based on the demo, we have a consensus; we strongly endorse using Cranium Cafe to counsel online students.

Please see below regarding how to purchase our subscription under OEI. I believe it will be around \$36K/year based on our overall FTES (full time equivalent students) + the initial set up

fee of \$1K.

We anticipate a pilot program in fall 2016 for DE students only. If you want to pilot it for only DE students for the first year (2016-17) then the total cost may be lower. Definition of DE student: A LPC student who is enrolled in at least one DE course (100% online).

Scott: Do you have an estimated number of DE students per year (based on the definition above)?

Diana/Barbara: Who is authorized to purchase our LPC subscription?

Next steps:

1. Purchase webcams for all the counseling faculty (at least 15--including the new counseling faculty). Gabby and Marina already have theirs so we can order the same model for the rest of us;
2. Identify a Counselor Lead to work with Cranium Cafe (I'd be willing to do this if nobody else wants to);
3. Get "play" accounts from Cranium Cafe, so that we can "talk/share" with each other;
4. All counseling faculty receive initial and continuous training so that we can all use Cranium Cafe;
5. Identify what hours we will provide online counseling appointments for DE students and with how many counselors for the Fall 2016 pilot program;
6. Since Cranium Cafe can be integrated with SARS, work with ITS and Cranium Cafe on identifying one central door (with lobby) on webpage so that online students can sign in (before we have the soft launch in fall 2016).
