This email is being sent to all of the Technology Committees for the colleges and district.

The Chabot and Las Positas Technology Committees and the district-wide Technology Coordinating Committee are very excited that we now have webmasters at all the locations: Wing Kam at Chabot, Tim Druley at LPC, and Katherine Tollefsen at District. We are now ready to evaluate and select a new Web Content Management System to be utilized at all locations that will enhance the website design process, facilitate content updates to web pages, and improve our responsiveness to needed changes to the various websites. We would like to have a single tool that works at all three sites instead of using a variety of software, such as Contribute and SharePoint 2007, which have limited capabilities and are not a comprehensive web content management system that aligns with the newest web technology.

The Technology Committees have formed a task force comprised of members from both colleges and district to review various products that are on the market and look at the software capabilities, the delivery models available and the related implementation considerations, and costs. The results of the task force's evaluation and recommendation will be presented back to each of the Technology Committees for their consensus which will be followed by a final recommendation back to the Chancellor's Senior Leadership Team made up of the Chancellor, Presidents, Vice Chancellors, and CTO.

The task force will be meeting every two weeks on Tuesday morning at 10:30 through Webinars starting the week of November 17th and their final recommendation will be presented during the Spring term 2016. The Webinar connection information for our first meeting on 11/17 is attached and Conference Room #2 at Dublin is reserved for those who can attend in person. We will keep you updated on their progress. We are looking forward to acquiring a tool that will significantly assist the colleges and district in their goal of doing complete redesigns of their websites.
