
The modules are in the very beginning stages of implementation -- we just rolled them out over the summer and have only tested it in one course so far (ENG 4). I haven't quite created any formal documentation about how to best implement, but here is some informal instructions on how to view and use.

What they are:

- Materials designed to give students a foundation in information literacy and critical thinking; with the specific goal of helping us bridge our gap in information literacy and library instruction for our online students.
- There is a pre-test at the beginning and then there are 6 total modules, with a post-test at the end.
- Each module has one or two quizzes to help assess the learning in that module.
- The modules and the quizzes can be imported into your Canvas course where students can interact with the material. The quizzes are automatically added to your grade book as assignments. You can then change the due date and and points they are worth. You can also delete parts of the modules that you do not want to use.



To view the full information literacy modules:

Click on "Credo Info Lit" under the Research Help tab in the library homepage menu (see image). These are not recommended to share with the students since they can be overwhelming as a whole and they are not automatically reported to you in your course.



To import into your course:

Select Commons from your navigation menu in Canvas. Then search for "Credo Info Lit" and toggle the button so that you only see LPC items. Select the module that you would like to import. Then select the course you would like to import it to, then click import. You should now see the modules in your course's modules and the quizzes in your grade book. Move around, delete, and change the grade points as needed.

It was great to see you yesterday evening! Thank you for coming to the orientation!

Thank you for letting me know -- your name somehow came through in the metadata of the results that we have received so far, which led me to want to check with you to see if you were using. I will have to investigate why/how that happened.

...and, yes! So far they look like they will be great! In our initial results we saw students scoring in the low 30%'s for the pre-test, but then in the upper 70's, low 80's for the end of module quizzes. So room for improvement in our implementation to get those quiz scores even higher, but definitely some promising initial results.
