

First-Time Any College: Students enrolled in college for the first time.


- First-Time Transfer: Students transferring to LPC in the current semester from another community college or university.

Concurrent Enrollment: A special admit student currently enrolled in K-12.






#### **Definitions:**

Other: Students completing diploma/GED requirements or moving from non-credit to credit courses. Data from admission application.



#### College Math:
