Respondents
Positive comments included appreciation for offering online courses so students who can't make it to campus can further their education. There were compliments about the Canvas software, as well as about instructor performance. On the negative side, students expressed frustration with some classes that were designed poorly, lacked interaction from the instructor, and included third-party tools that were difficult to use. A couple students wanted more choice in instructors so they can choose their courses more wisely.
