
S.F. Business Times State of the Tri-Valley Panelist, August 20, 2020

Below are some key notes and best practices prior to logging in:

- You must join from a laptop or PC; the system is not compatible with mobile or Ipads.
- Before joining as a remote guest, please disconnect from VPN if you are using one. Restart your computer, confirm you are not on a
- VPN connection, and then you can join via the remote guest link.
- Headsets and earbuds are ok, though we have had issues with Air Pods. I would discourage using Bluetooth headsets/ear buds if possible.
- · When joining, please make sure to pay attention to the top of your window in case Google Chrome asks you for permission to access your
- · camera and microphone. Allow access if asked.
