As Signed into Law, Ed-Code 87450.4 (a) (2) now reads: "It is the intent of the Legislature in enacting this section to adopt a formula for general purpose apportionments that encourages access for underrepresented students, provides additional funding in recognition of the need to provide additional support for low-income students, rewards colleges' progress on improving student success metrics, and improves overall equity and predictability so that community college districts may more readily plan and implement instruction and programs."

A reasonable Question to Ask: How well does the Funding Formula (as enacted) meet this legislative goal?

Out of 1,538,497 student headcount indicated for Pell Grants, Promise Grants, & AB 504 Fee Waivers (i.e., the data used to calculate the Supplemental Allocation) ...

- **542,732 students (35.3% of the targeted total)** attend districts in which the Supplemental Allocation accounts for a negative impact in total funding, meaning it drives no additional support for these students.
- **283,391 students (18.4% of the targeted total),** enough to fill three Rose Bowls, attend districts for which the Supplemental Allocation accounts for a reduction of 3% or more in total funding—so for nearly a fifth of targeted underrepresented students, the "Student Centered Funding Formula" will likely force a reduction of programs and services that they already have.

IMPORTANT: The Supplemental Allocation does not appear to have been vetted for harmful outcomes. In addition to neglecting significant proportions of students receiving financial aid as shown above, the Supplemental Allocation systematically neglects underrepresented students (of myriad stripes) who are unable to benefit from financial aid, including students in high-cost areas who can't qualify for aid, but who nonetheless face food and/or housing insecurity. The aggregate result is a funding formula which—despite its laudible intent—is especially discriminatory to students living in the most inequitable employment and housing markets in the state, and country.
