

Academic Senate Resolution for Budget Accountability

Whereas, Under Board Policy 2200, the Board of Trustees for the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District is expressly responsible for representing the public interest and assuring fiscal health and stability of the district;

Whereas, each year, the Board of Trustees adopts a budget for the District, which includes budgets for both Colleges, for the District Office, and for Maintenance and Operations:

Whereas, The Chabot-Las Positas Community College District is accountable for its budget allocation from the State of California;

Whereas, In 2016-17, Chabot College overspent its allotted budget by over \$2.5 million dollars:

Whereas, An inquiry into this overspending and reviewing internal control processes, policies, and procedures would help to ensure that future overspending could be avoided;

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Las Positas College requests that the Board of Trustees appoint a task force to conduct an inquiry and issue a report about the \$2.5 million dollar overspending by Chabot College in 2016-17; and

Resolved, That the Academic Senate of Las Positas College requests that the terms of repayment and the rationale for the terms be included in the report.
