School Violence & the Active Shooter

HOSTED BY: LAS POSITAS COLLEGE PUBLIC SAFETY PROGRAM and ACTIVE SHOOTER/CRITICAL INCIDENT TASK FORCE

<u>Description:</u> This 4 hour course is designed for school faculty to address the threat of an active shooter and other violent critical incidents on school (K-12) and college/university campuses. It is no secret that the actions of school faculty during a critical incident will save more lives than responding law enforcement officers. Statistically, once the shooting starts a life is taken every 15 seconds. It is imperative school faculty act quickly when implementing a response to school violence.

During this course of instruction, attendees will receive informative presentations on the history and dynamics of school shootings, insight regarding basic firearms (sounds made), Awareness - Preparation - Response tactics for educators, defensive classroom mindset and on building relationships with local law enforcement.

Tuition: No Cost

Funded through Bay Area UASI (Homeland Security Grant Program)

<u>Prerequisites:</u> Attendees must be a school faculty member employed within the twelve-county Bay Area UASI Region, which includes the counties of Marin, Sonoma, Napa, Solano, Contra Costa, Alameda, San Mateo, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, San Benito, Monterey and San Francisco.
