The committee met to prioritize 17 requests for faculty positions. Each department requesting a position(s) had 2 minutes to explain the reason their request is important to LPC.

-English-AB705 will require re-writing curriculum, mentoring and working on Guided Pathways.

-Computer Science-The program has increased 5x recently and hard to find part time faculty because they can find better paying jobs elsewhere.

-Math-70% of classes are taught by part-time faculty, AB705 will require lots of curriculum changes.

-Theater- CTE program in Theater Tech is down one instructor, this is a dangerous position and requires someone qualified for student safety.

-Communication Studies-replacement

-Biology-3rd largest department, many courses are waitlisted.

-Chemistry-needed as a prereq for many areas and need at least 2 full time to meet current demands.

-CNT-replacement, needed to teach CISCO academy and Google certification.

-Computer Science-one replacement, one new

-Counselor 1-replacement-retention and intervention

-Counselor 2-New Career/transfer -LPC 3rd highest transfer in the state

-Counselor 3-New Puente 50% funding mandate from state

-Counselor 4-New Athletics, all student athletes must have comp SEP by 10/15 each year

-Counselor 5-New Middle College, to serve middle college students
