8.	<ul> <li>CTE Funding For discussion <ul> <li>Vicki shared the Strong Workforce Program budget spreadsheet for Local Fund 333280;</li> <li>LPC's FY 22/23 final allocation was \$650,058.92 which is 37% of the total allocation, with Chabot College receiving the other 63%.</li> <li>Vicki also reported on Perkins funding sharing that we received \$393,212.96, then we received a memo from the state saying they were going to increase with an augmentation so we received an additional \$76,525 which is 36% of the total allocation, with Chabot College receiving the other 64%.</li> <li>Employee Compensation increases (~11%) will impact all of our CTE funding, so we need to leverage the augmentation with the employee compensation increases.</li> <li>More information on this in October's meeting pending FA approval</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Vicki Shipman
