- Public Comments (This time is reserved for members of the public to address the Curriculum Committee. Please limit comments to three minutes. In accordance with the Brown Act, the Curriculum Committee cannot act on these items.)
 - Christina Lee stated that as a Psychology-Counseling faculty member she would like to request that the Curriculum Committee table voting on PSYC 21: Introduction to Cross-Cultural Psychology and reintroduce in to the Curriculum Committee in the fall. Psychology- Counseling faculty have been working with Psychology faculty on revising the course outline of PSYC 21. After reviewing the revised version of the course outline, Marina Lira and Christina Lee met with four members of the Psychology Department to see about the possibility of adding a statement to the course outline that states that the students that have completed PCN 13 may not receive any credit for taking PSYC 21. This is because the Psychology- Counseling faculty feel that the course content overlap is about 80% and for that reason do not want students to take both courses. The Psychology- Counseling faculty feel that the measurable outcomes and course content of PSYC 21, it mirrors PCN 13: Multicultural Issues in Contemporary America. PCN 13 has been taught as Las Positas for the last twenty years. This same statement would also be added to PCN 13 effective fall 2018. This will allow students to know that they should not take both courses, but instead look at take other social justice course. These courses cannot be cross listed as the Psychology Counseling faculty feel that courses are not completely the same and , as the course is articulated to UC and CSU's, they do not want to change the content of the course. In conclusion, please table voting until the fall semester so this language can possible be added (not sure if the state mandates that this language can only be used if courses are cross-listed).

Discussion regarding PSYC 21: Craig Kutil clarified that there is nothing in Ed Code, Title 5, the Chancellor's Office, or Academic Senate about how to deal with courses that have duplication of content. Many courses on this campus have duplication of content. For example, a sociology and anthology course have very similar content to PCN 13. We may want to set up a policy regarding duplication of content. However, currently we only include a statement regarding credit only being received for one course, if the courses are cross-listed. Marina Lira posed the question why we could not use this language for this course if we do not currently have a policy. Craig Kutil clarified that if we did use this language for these courses, we would have to review all courses on campus that have been approved by the Curriculum Committee for overlapping content. John Ruys posed the question if there is a standard of how much duplicate content we do not want students take. Craig Kutil did find another colleges do have policies on this topic that we could use as a guide. Marina Lira stated that from talking to both the Psychology- Counseling and Psychology departments the issue that has arisen is that most of the content of PSYC 21 and PCN 13 overlaps (about 80%). The courses utilize the same textbook and measurable objectives. Sheena Turner-August stated that in a diversity course you are looking at very similar topics and materials, while there is overlap the difference is the perspective from which the course is taught. Jill Oliveira asked about the risk as an institution of limits being put on students in terms of credit from UC. Roanna Bennie stated that a path has to be chosen, that the courses need to either be the same and cross-listed or different enough to be put forward as different courses. John Ruys stated that PCN 13 is really about American cultural identity, while PSYC 21 is about internal identity and internal processes. Marina Lira stated that a PCN 13 syllabus was provided to the Psychology faculty and the content was the same due to both courses using the same textbook. It was clarified that it is a psychology textbook. Sheena Turner- August stated that this is due to a lack of diversity textbooks that course materials are supplemented with outside books and research. Marina Lira had asked the Psychology faculty to integrate their perspective to differentiate the course. Sheena Turner-August explained that she made those changes, including added more psychology jargon. Colin Schatz stated that perhaps this issue cannot be resolved with in this meeting. Marina Lira specified that if tabled, if brought back to the committee in September and voted on in October it will still have the same effective date of Fall 2018.

6. Discussion Items

• 2017-18 Calendar

Craig Kutil stated that there will be a mandatory Curriculum Training on College Day for all committee members. This is required by Ed Code and Title 5 and has been previously done at the first curriculum meeting of the semester. He described that this summer one project that he will be working on is updating the Curriculum Handbook. There will be a 5th Monday meeting in October, as the Board will approve Curriculum in both November and January. This will help increase the speed of curriculum being approved at the Chancellor's Office, especially noncredit, which is still being reviewed. There will also be three Curriculum Meetings in April. This calendar will be sent out to the Dean's to be presented at Wednesday's division meetings.

• AP Policy

Marina Lira stated that in September 2016 Bill 1985 was passed into law, which effected our local AP Chart. Community Colleges were told to follow the CSU AP Chart. The CSU defined that AP Credit could be awarded in general education areas. This is not in the new catalog, as the policy change came in form of a memo after the catalog had already gone to print. This is something that we will need to be discussed in the fall, for the new catalog, as we can no longer attach a course to the AP Examination, but instead GE Areas. This will affect the number of units that we will provide to students, since the Chancellor's Offices uses the language of "minimum semester units". It is unclear if campuses individually can award more units. A memo from the CSU Chancellor's Office in February was released regarding ADT. At Community Colleges, ADTs have been awarded based on the local agreed upon number of units that AP score is worth. However, CSU systems are only counting AP credit for units based on their own standards. Thus, if a CSU system counts the AP Credit for less units than awarded at the Committee College the student may not have met the sixty-unit minimum and may be denied entrance. A poll of the CSUs showed mixed results if a CSU would grant acceptance with an ADT, even if from their perspective the minimum 60 units have not been met. If we are going to award units above the CSU AP Chart, we will need to be future discussion of how this can be put on a transcript. Craig Kutil stated that he would research this more at the Curriculum Institute.

• Minimum Grade for Requisite Courses

Craig Kutil stated that we have some course outlines that have a minimum grade of B, primarily in EMS. There is nothing in Title 5 that says that it cannot be done, however if students then gets a "C" they cannot move on to the next course or repeat the course. This has created a situation where faculty members are offering to give students who earned a "C" a "D" in order that they can repeat the course. He believes that faculty members could adjust their grading scale to make a "C" 80%. The EMS Faculty were concerned about student complaining about this policy; however, it would be documented on the syllabi. This effect consistency with in the catalog and Banner.

• Catalog Updates

Craig Kutil stated that there is inconsistency in the catalog regarding program descriptions. There are program descriptions in CurricUNET that are not in the catalog. Many of the AD-T descriptions have been moved to be descriptions of the general overarching program. Some programs do not have descriptions, but only Program Student Learning Outcomes. In addition, AD-T's should include in the catalog the number of General Education Units for CSU and IGETC and Elective CSU Transferable Units. CurricUNET is missing a lot of information for older programs, but updating is an easy process. Roanna Bennie stated that in the new catalog, it might include awkward or old information for courses and programs, but that is what is in the approved Curriculum Inventory. If those items need to be changed in needs to go through the Curriculum Committee. However, the general department description will just need to be looking at the catalog to see what parts of their program should be updated. Craig Kutil stated that program review has been updated to ask these questions, including looking at their overall department description. The committee thought that more than half of faculty members would be interested in a catalog. They will be printed in the summer for the fall semester.

• Proposed Curriculum Process

Craig Kutil explained that there is a proposed update to Title 5, which will most likely by approved this summer. This change will require that outside-of- class hours to be on course outlines. Currently, only lecture and lab hours are calculated course outlines. We will not change CurricUNET, until this is approved. According to the Carnegie Rule for every hour of lecture there are two hours expected outside of class. This only will effectlecture, as laboratory is considered all in class hours. Studio Lab is not acceptable and courses with Studio Labs need to be updated.

• Non-Credit Update

Kristy Woods stated that the Noncredit Taskforce has been working diligently on noncredit. She encouraged the members of the committee to read the noncredit frequently asked questions document posted to blackboard. Craig Kutil explained that noncredit pages have been created in CurricUNET, but Governet still needs to make changes to the pages for them to fit noncredit. Roanna Bennie stated that at the District they would like to know what are the parameters, philosophy, and goals of noncredit. Kristy Woods stated that from being at the noncredit summit, we can expect those items to grow and change especially as the state changes their own philosophy. Roanna Bennie explained that there is an effort at the district to keep our noncredit philosophy to be similar to Chabot's philosophy. There will be a meeting between the campuses before we can move forward.

• Discipline List Change Process

Craig Kutil explained that he will be working on processes to go into the handbook that will be brought to the committee in the fall. He believes that the process should be that if the discipline is being changed, the course outline should come the Curriculum Committee for approval.

• Program Student Learning Outcome Process

Craig Kutil stated PSLOs have been required to be on our programs and then go to the state for the approval. Madeline Wiest explained that new programs are not in eLumen, so potentially faculty could add PSLOs in CurricUNET and she could manually put the PSLOs on the SLO Committee agenda. It was discussed that PSLOs should already be approved before the programs are approved by the Curriculum Committee. It was discussed that every time PSLOs are updated, the program should be updated through curriculum. Roanna Bennie stated a process needs to be created and the topic revisited in the fall.

• Curriculum Streamlining

Craig Kutil explained that now only Public Safety, Work Experience, Noncredit courses will be reviewed at the State. All other courses will receive roll over approval in the Curriculum Inventory. This means that the VP and Curriculum Chair will now signing off on all curriculum. Currently in CurricUNET the VP only approves a course after it has already been approved by the Curriculum Committee. Roanna Bennie stated it seems that she will now need to be involved sooner in the process. She ask the committee to think about the best way to make this change in the future. Craig Kutil proposed that the VP is added in CurricUNET as an approver after the Dean's. Roanna Bennie stated that the Curriculum Streamlining workshop would be at the district next Tuesday. She discussed that we will begin be updating the handbook and should be reviewing policies.

• Curriculum Update Cycle

Next semester we can discuss have each division have a year were they update their curriculum. The course updates could be spread out across both the fall and spring semester. Also, that new and modified programs should only be effective in Fall so that the catalog is always correct. For courses there can be a catalog addendum for any updates.

Craig Kutil thanked the committee for all of their hard work. He stated he will be curriculum chair for the next two years, but hopes that for future curriculum chair they are selected not the semester they start the role. This will allow for more time for training with the current curriculum chair and go to a curriculum institute. He would like that next year every member of the curriculum committee receive a copy of the Min Quals Handbook, TOP Code Manual and the PCAH. We are looking to add a rationale page by fall in CurriUNET, where faculty can check off what they have update specifically with regard to units, title, prerequisites. Hopefully, noncredit will be able to come to the committee for review by the fall. Also, he explained that he would like to increase the membership of the committee to two representative per division, ideally not from the same department to allow for varied perspective.
