6.	Spring FTEF ask for District
	VP Ho reporting: We made a collaborative effort to try to find a way to predict our spring enrollment. From
	those efforts came the "Spring 2024 Enrollment Management" document which was shared with the
	committee. VP Ho explained the information on the document in detail. This will be the basis of the foundation
	that we will send to the vice chancellor.
	Total possible 402.32; 449.85 if cross-listed. We will need to discuss how we will fund the 449 since our
	allocation target from DEMC is 400.1.
	The deans also made comments regarding the work from their areas.
	It's this committee's decision to review and weigh in on this strategy. We have three choices:
	1. No change and bank on having cancellations.
	2. Put on all of spring (don't know the number yet).
	3. Put on spring as it is in our discipline plans and ask for more.
	After discussion the committee made a decision.
	MSC: Ask the District for the third choice, 14 FTEF with backfill for up to an additional 10 FTEF
	(Chopra/Mattern); committee approved.
	VP Ho will take this decision to Executive Staff (it might be modified there), then to DEMC.
