By being able to walk around the classroom with headphones to listen and talk, instead of having to sit at the instructor's keyboard, teaching piano will be much easier and more akin to how a traditional piano lesson is taught. The video found here explains how the upgrade enhances teaching quite well:

Piano, theory, and composition students need to have one-on-one feedback from their instructor to learn effectively. Currently, students cannot always show instructors their hands or their sheet music if they are working at a keyboard which is further from the instructor station. With this new technology, the instructor will be walking around the room, and students can get much more valuable.
