MADD Programs:

College Presentation: Designed as an overview about MADD, and how college students in particular can be a part of the solution to lead toward a future with No More Victims through making healthy decisions when it comes to alcohol and other drugs. The presentation discusses issues of how drunk driving and underage drinking specifically impact college students. We talk about planning ahead when alcohol or other drugs are involved, and to always have a safe way home. Finally, we talk about what to do if the student thinks he/she or one of their friends may have a problem with alcohol or other drugs. Real life victim stories are used to help illustrate that by other's choices.

Power of Parents: Workshop for parents of middle and high school students to help empower them to have ongoing, intentional conversations about the dangers and consequences of underage drinking.

Educational Materials: Can be distributed electronically.

General MADD Presentation: An overview of our organization which includes information about the impact of alcohol and other substances in relationship to DUI arrests and crashes.

Victim Story: MADD Volunteer who is either a DUI survivor or a relative of a DUI victim shares their story to help the community understand the lasting and long-term effects of impaired driving.
