He read through the resolution and shared the link to the document. <p><b><a href="#">AB 361</a>, Vote to Continue Meetings Online</b> (Action) - Tyler Rivas</p>	<p><i>Tyler Rivas will discuss the need to stay online and seek approval to stay online for the next 30 days.</i></p> <p>-</p> <p><i>Tyler Rivas explained that an amendment was passed for local governments to meet remotely when COVID-19 initially occurred. The adoption of AB 361 was implemented as an emergency measure to continue virtual meetings under two circumstances: a declared state of emergency or a majority vote to stay online (which takes place every 30 days).
