Your completed instructional program review packet should include:

- Part I:
 - Self-study
 - SLO worksheet (as attachment)
 - Curriculum worksheet (as attachment)
- Part II: Planning Forms
 - Program Maintenance
 - Program Development
- Common Tools (separate)
 - Maintenance needs
 - Development needs

Time line for completion of instructional program review

November 5, 2010

The completed instructional program review packet is to be submitted to the IPRC for validation. Prior to that date, you should have reviewed your program review packet with your Dean.

November-December 2010:

IPR Committee will conduct validation

January 2011:

IPR Committee will notify Programs and Deans of results of validation.

Early February 2011:

Revisions, if needed, are due back to IPR Committee

February 2011:

Faculty members will be asked to complete an evaluation of the instructional program forms and process.

January-February 2011:

The common tool and outcomes of instructional program review will be integrated into the institutional plan.

March 2011:

The common tool is submitted to the IEC in March 2011.

May 2012:

Disciplines update common tool
