Opposing Viewpoints, CQ Researcher, Ethnic NewsWatch, GenderWatch

MLA

Note: you will need to read each page carefully if you are citing an item (example, abstract of a journal article, cartoon, etc.) in each of the sections below. When you are typing in the specific information (example, title and author). NoodleBib provides instructions each step of the way.

Article from a Viewpoint Essay or Primary Documents in Opposing Viewpoints (MLA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Journal” citation type
- Select “Reprint in a book”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “Subscription database” for the content
- Enter “Opposing Viewpoints” as the Name of the Database
- Select “Thomson Gale Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center”
- Do NOT change the URL information. The Library has set this up for you.
- Note: The source citation information about the book is at the bottom of the essay.

Magazine Article in Opposing Viewpoints (MLA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Magazine” citation type
- Select “Magazine”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “An article” as the source
- Select “Yes, information about a print publication is provided”
- Select “Subscription database” for the content
- Enter “Opposing Viewpoints” as the Name of the Database
- Select “Thomson Gale Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center”
- Do NOT change the URL information. The Library has set this up for you.

Newspaper Article in Opposing Viewpoints (MLA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Newspaper or Newswire” citation type
- Select “Newspaper or Newswire”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “An article” as the source
- Select “Yes, information about a print publication is provided”
- Select “Subscription database” for the content
- Enter “Opposing Viewpoints” as the Name of the Database
- Select “Thomson Gale Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center”
- Do NOT change the URL information. The Library has set this up for you.

Magazine Article in CQ Researcher (MLA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Magazine” citation type
- Select “Magazine”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “An article” as the source
- Select “Yes, information about a print publication is provided”
- Select “Periodical Subscription” for the content
- Select “Unique URL” to find the source again
- The name of the magazine is “CQ Researcher”, when you get to the field “Unique URL” copy the URL information from the CQ Researcher article after you click on “Citenow!” link

Magazine Article in Ethnic NewsWatch or GenderWatch (MLA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Magazine” citation type
- Select “Magazine”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “An article” as the source
- Select “Yes, information about a print publication is provided”
- Select “Subscription database” for the content
- Enter “Ethnic NewsWatch” or “GenderWatch” as the Name of the Database
- Select “ProQuest”
- Do NOT change the URL information. The Library has set this up for you.

Newspaper Article in Ethnic NewsWatch or GenderWatch (MLA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Newspaper or Newswire” citation type
- Select “Newspaper or Newswire”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “An article” as the source
- Select “Yes, information about a print publication is provided”
- Select “Subscription database” for the content
- Enter “Ethnic NewsWatch” or “GenderWatch” as the Name of the Database
- Select “ProQuest”
- Do NOT change the URL information. The Library has set this up for you.

APA

Article from a Viewpoint Essay or Primary Documents in Opposing Viewpoints (APA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Magazine” citation type
- Select “Reprint in a book”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “Aggregated database” for the content
- Enter the information about the Book, Reprinted Material when you get to the field “Name of aggregated database” enter “Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center”
- Do NOT enter the URL information. APA does not require URL information
- Note: The source citation information about the book is at the bottom of the essay.

Magazine Article in Opposing Viewpoints (APA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Magazine” citation type
- Select “Magazine”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “A basic magazine article” as the source
- Select “Aggregated database” for the content
- Enter the information about the magazine when you get to the field “Name of aggregated database” enter “Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center”
- Do NOT enter the URL information. APA does not require URL information

Newspaper Article in Opposing Viewpoints (APA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Newspaper or Newswire” citation type
- Select “Newspaper or Newswire”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “An article” as the source
- Select “Aggregated database” for the content
- Enter the information about the magazine when you get to the field “Name of aggregated database” enter “Opposing Viewpoints Resource Center”
- Do NOT enter the URL information. APA does not require URL information.

Magazine Article in CQ Researcher (APA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Magazine” citation type
- Select “Magazine”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “A basic magazine article” as the source
- Select “Exact reproduction of original printed source” for the content
- The name of the magazine is “CQ Researcher”

Newspaper Article in Ethnic NewsWatch or GenderWatch (APA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Newspaper or Newswire” citation type
- Select “Newspaper or Newswire”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “An article” as the source
- Select “Aggregated database” for the content
- Enter the information about the newspaper article when you get to the field “Name of aggregated database” enter “Ethnic NewsWatch” or enter “GenderWatch”
- Do NOT enter the URL information. APA does not require URL information

Magazine Article in Ethnic NewsWatch or GenderWatch (APA)

- Choose the “Periodicals -- Magazine” citation type
- Select “Magazine”
- Select “Online” as the publication medium
- Select “A basic magazine article” as the source
- Select “Aggregated database” for the content
- Enter the information about the magazine when you get to the field “Name of aggregated database” enter “Ethnic NewsWatch” or enter “GenderWatch”
- Do NOT enter the URL information. APA does not require URL information
