Summary: 74 responses. Lots of positive comments about instructors and classes. Positive comments centered around the organization and structure of certain courses, along with the willingness of specific instructors to respond to student emails promptly, offer help and guidance, and offer encouragement. Lots of negative comments, too. Negative comments centered around a desire for more interaction, particularly with the instructor. Several students wished the instructor would reply to their queries faster. Some were not happy with the structure of their classes, namely the disorganization of content and the last-minute changes made by instructors. A couple wanted all online courses to be standardized so it is easier to find content. A few students said their classes were unprofessional-looking, with many spelling and grammar errors. Several mentioned that their classes took more time than face-to-face classes. Some thought the time limits for exams were too short. A few mentioned their dislike of Blackboard and Zonemail.
