

GUARANTEED TRANSFER PROGRAMS



Las Positas College provides transfer students with a variety of opportunities to participate in guaranteed transfer programs. Currently, there are programs that guarantee transfer to at least 39 colleges and universities.

- The University of California system has a Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program at 6 of its campuses.
- The California State University system has an Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) program that guarantees students admission to its campuses, based on major and impactation status. LPC students may be guaranteed admission to 9 CSU campuses.
- Numerous independent and in/out-state-colleges, and universities also have Transfer Admissions Agreements (TAA) with Las Positas College.

UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (UC) “TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE (TAG)” PATHWAY

- Transfer agreements enable students to GUARANTEE transfer admission without obligation to attend.
- Available at: 6 University of California campuses
 - UC Davis
 - UC Santa Barbara
 - UC Merced
 - UC Irvine
 - UC Riverside
 - UC Santa Cruz
- Transfer pathways to UC Berkeley, UCLA and UC San Diego are available but not guaranteed.
- Only students transferring directly from a California Community College are considered for a TAG, including international students.
- Specific courses and grades are required.
- Students may apply for a UC TAG to only one participating UC Campus, but can apply for transfer to any UC campus.
- Students should meet with a counselor during their first year to complete a Student Education Plan to plan for and ensure eligibility for the TAG program.



CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY (CSU) “ASSOCIATE DEGREE FOR TRANSFER (ADT)” PATHWAY

- The ADT is a unique transfer pathway that students can use for guaranteed admission to one of the 23 California State Universities
 - An option that allows students to complete an Associate’s Degree while satisfying general education and major requirements for transfer
- The ADT follows a prescribed pattern of courses for specific majors (AA-T and AS-T)
 - Students are guaranteed admission to a local CSU in non-selective major
 - For impacted campuses and majors, students with guaranteed transfer degrees are given additional consideration for transfer admission.

HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES & UNIVERSITIES (HBCU) TRANSFER GUARANTEE AGREEMENTS

In 2015, the California Community College Chancellor's Office signed an agreement with several Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) to offer California community college students who complete certain academic requirements guaranteed transfer to a participating HBCUs. - 1. Career & Transfer Workshop Series**
