ALL STUDENTS SHOULD APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID. IT'S FREE AND EASY!

Las Positas College offers federal and state financial assistance to eligible students. Financial aid helps ensure that each student has sufficient financial resources to enable them to attend college. Las Positas College provides fee waivers, grants, scholarships, loans, and work-study. Financial aid funds are provided to help with all costs of attending college, including but not limited to, enrollment fees or tuition, textbooks, school supplies, room and board, personal and living expenses, transportation, childcare, and computers. All students are encouraged to apply for financial aid.

FINANCIAL AID AVAILABLE:

CALIFORNIA COLLEGE PROMISE GRANT FEE WAIVER	California College Promise Grants (formerly known as the Board of Governors Fee Waiver – BOGW) waive the enrollment fee for California residents or students eligible for AB 540 status, and do not have to be repaid.
LPC PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP	The LPC Promise Scholarship is offered to eligible California resident students who enroll in at least 9 units, receive a California College Promise Grant and have and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) greater than \$3,100.
CAL GRANT	Cal Grants are awarded to eligible California resident students or AB 540 who are pursuing an undergraduate degree or vocational or career training, and do not have to be repaid.
FEDERAL PELL GRANT	Federal Pell Grants are a need-based grant awarded to low-income undergraduate students to promote access to postsecondary education, and do not have to be repaid.
FEDERAL WORK-STUDY	Federal Work-Study provides part-time jobs for undergraduate students with financial need, allowing them to earn money to help pay education expenses. Money earned through Federal Work-Study does not have to be repaid.
FEDERAL DIRECT STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM	Federal Direct Student Loan Program provides low interest loans to eligible undergraduate students to help cover the costs of higher education. Loans must be repaid with interest.
SCHOLARSHIPS	Scholarships are free money made available to students based on numerous factors that may include academic success, co-curricular, extracurricular activities, academic majors, or career interests. Scholarships do not have to be repaid.

FINANCIAL AID APPLICATIONS:

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid, better known as the FAFSA, is the most commonly used financial aid application to apply for federal, state, and local financial assistance. The FAFSA should be completed online at **fafsa.gov**. Federal School Code **030357**.

The California Dream Act Application, also known as CADAA, should be completed by students who are undocumented and have been granted AB 540 status by the Admissions & Records Office. The CADAA should be completed online at **dream.csac.ca.gov**.
