Las Positas College **Graduation Survey Spring 2016: Results** Degrees, Plans, and Demographics

The Graduation Survey was administered before the Commencement ceremony in May 2016. It was filled out by 203 out of 266 degree and certificate graduates in attendance; a response rate of 76.3%. Overall, 578 students graduated in 2015-16. These results provide an insight into student completion patterns and future plans after graduation. Seventy-three percent of graduates received an Associate of Arts (A.A./A.A.-T). Twenty-one percent of graduates recieved an Associate of Science (A.S./A.S.-T). The most popular majors were Business (21%) and Psychology (12%). More than half of graduates plan to transfer to a university in the following Fall, while 18% of students plan to continue their education at a community college. Over 31% of graduates plan to continue in their current job.
