STUDENT ELECTION RESULTS

The Associated Students of Las Positas College (ASLPC) hosted a student election the week of Monday, November 13th through Saturday, November 18th via CLASS-Web and there were two initiatives on the ballot for students to consider. The first initiative was a Student Mobility Initiative (transportation fee) to financially subsidize the Wheels bus program to and from campus effective fall 2018. The second initiative was an official name change of student government from ASLPC to Las Positas College Student Government. Both initiatives were passed with an overwhelming level of support. Congratulations to Scott Miner and our student leaders!

FASTPASS SUCCESS

In November 2017, the Las Positas College Admissions & Records Office, Assessment Center, Counseling Department, Financial Aid Office, and Outreach Office hosted a call to action event titled, "Fastpass" for three evenings prior to open registration for spring semester 2018. The event resulted in 55 students applying for admission and viewing the online orientation, 95 students taking the assessment tests, and 35 students receiving an abbreviated student educational plan for a total of 185 services provided. As a result, Las Positas College plans to host another Fastpass from Monday, April 30th through Thursday, May 3rd in preparation for summer and fall 2018. Congratulations to all involved!

HUNGER FREE CAMPUS SUPPORT ALLOCATION

In fall 2017, the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office announced one-time funds to help address food insecurities had by students enrolled at California community colleges and to designate a college employee to help students enroll in CalFresh. Las Positas College was allocated \$15,548 to explore the possibility of serving as a food distribution center in collaboration with the Alameda County Food Bank. The Student Life Office in collaboration with our student leaders plan to work on this initiative in spring semester 2018. Additional information to be forthcoming.
