#### 1. Welcome and Introductions

William Garcia

William Garcia, Vice President of Student Services, welcomed all attendees and distributed a hard copy of the agenda to all attendees. No introductions needed.

# 2. Approval of Agenda (02/20/18)

# **3. Approval of Minutes (11/21/17)**

The minutes from the November 21, 2017 not approved pending further review and a vote at our next division meeting scheduled for March 20, 2018.

## 4. Welcome of New Dean of Student Services William Garcia

Unfortunately, Elizabeth David, our new Dean of Student Services was unable to join us for the meeting but William Garcia asked all Student Services personnel for their help in welcoming the new dean to the college if they had not already done so.

#### 5. Personnel Recruitments

William Garcia

#### a. Dean, Enrollment Services

William Garcia announced that the recruitment for the Dean, Enrollment Services position began on February 2, 2018 and that the position would close on February 28, 2018. William thanked the Student Services personnel who agreed to serve on the hiring committee. The new Dean, Enrollment Services will begin on or soon after July 1, 2018.

#### b. Counselor, DSPS

William Garcia announced that the recruitment for the Counselor, Disabled Student Programs and Services (DSPS)

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position began on February 2, 2018 and that the position would close on February 28, 2018. William thanked the Student Services personnel who agreed to serve on the hiring committee. The new Counselor, DSPS will begin at the start of the fall semester 2018.

#### c. Director, DSPS

William Garcia announced that the recruitment for the Director, DSPS has yet to begin due to a delay at the College and at the District Office. The recruitment will begin within the new few weeks. However, the hiring committee has already met and William thanked the Student Services personnel who agreed to serve on the hiring committee. Additional information to be forthcoming.

#### 6. Student Services Reorganization

William Garcia announced that a minor reorganization will take place at Las Positas College effective July 1, 2018 and that it will affect Student Services as follows:

#### a. Bookstore

The Bookstore will report to Administrative Services effective July 1, 2018. This is no reflection of our current contract with Follett or the personnel assigned to the Bookstore including Nolan Howe, Bookstore Manager. This change will better align contracted services under Administrative Services, as is the case at most California community colleges.

# b. EOPS, CARE, CalWORKs, DSPS

The four state funded categorical programs will report to the Dean, Student Services effective July 1, 2018. This change will align all state funded categorical programs under one dean.

#### c. Articulation

The Faculty Hiring Prioritization Process recommended the hiring of a full-time Articulation Officer effective fall 2018. The recruitment is currently underway. The new Articulation Officer will report to the Office of the Vice President of Academic Services.

#### d. Tutorial Center

The Tutorial Center will report to Don Carlson, Dean of Academic Services effective July 1, 2018. This will help realize the plan to create a unified tutorial center with other academic support programs.

# 7. LPC Scholarships Andi Schreibman

Andi Schreibman, Financial Aid Officer, announced that the Las Positas College Scholarship is now available online for students. There is over \$400,000 in scholarship funds available. Mertes bequest scholarship funds are also available for transfer students from both Chabot College and Las Positas College. The deadline to apply is March 11, 2018 at 11:59 p.m. All students are encouraged to apply. Flyers and posters are available from the Financial Aid Office.

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# 8. LPC Fastpass Event for Summer/Fall 2018
