Hi David:

Thank you for submitting the program maps for the AA and AA-T in Art. This is very helpful and important work that will benefit students down the line. I do have some thoughts and a response to your feedback on the back page of the AA-T:

- 1) You mention that you believe Arhs 2 and 7 might be added as art history options for the AA-T in Studio Art. I checked curricunet for the 2020 update, and those courses do not appear. If you believe that they should be added and are in line with the Transfer Model Curriculum

(TMC) requirements, please consult curriculum chair / articulation officer Craig Kutil, as he could let you know if you have the option to add them, and if so help you do that.

Additionally I have a suggestion regarding scheduling:

- 2) You have mapped arts 2A and arts 23 for the fall semester. I reviewed the Fall 2019 and discovered the scheduling as it was would permit this (see below) due to 23 overlapping with both available sections of 2A. When scheduling for Fall 2020, you want to insure that these sections don't overlap. This will help students, and will be good for your programs enrollments as well.

- 3) I agree that the "Second Semester" as a curricular area is confusing. I've made it work for now, but its worth updating through curriculum to make more clear. This wouldn't be a "substantive change" I wouldn't think, so should be something easy to do. Again, contact the curriculum chair to see if this could be clarified.

Given the uncertainty of the proposed change to the AA-T, I have updated the 2 degree map as you submitted them (with a few GE modifications). If a change to include additional art history is approved, let me know and we'll add them to the maps. Please take a look and let me know if you have any corrections or suggestions.
