 - The steering committee review proposed introductory courses for students, the drafts of the PSST webpages and student resource guide, and provided feedback.

- 5. Pillar 2: CCCApply Jared Howard
 - <u>Proposed Phase 1 and Inquiry Phase 2</u> changes to major selection
 - Goal of Fall 2022 September 15th 2022
 - Campus conversations to inform proposal of phase 1
 - Jared shared what the CCCApply process looks like for students, specifically the section that asks questions about their major. Currently it is not helpful in determining student majors, because it does not list all the possible majors but the 204 programs LPC offers. We hope to enhance this experience by listing *major categories* instead which would give students a more general major list (about 30-40 choices) to choose from.

 - Our goal is that at some point guided pathways is an US thing and it just exists, so we will be working on shifting our work so that our work is embedded in everything we do without having to have a committee drive it.

 - Emerald Templeton
 - Emerald shared that REACH has selected two pathways for the program: OSH and Red Hat Administration. We are working on creating some deliverables to provide to the chancellors' office including promotional videos, brochures, mailers etc. The main goal of REACH is to help prepare students to enter high demand livable wage jobs. So our next steps will be to identify courses that could onboard students to these programs.
