  - Dr. Foster then provided and update on matriculation, sharing that we have a consulting firm that will help us review our onboarding process in Spring 2022 to help us identify any barriers and improvements we could make.

# Persistence Project (Pillar 3: Staying on the Pathway)

- Jim Ott and Jeff Judd
  - Jim and Jeff provided an update on Cohort 2 for Fall 2021 by sharing some data that Rajinder help put together.
  - Data:
    - PP students had a 10% higher success rate (C or better) than non PP students
    - PP students had 60% better persistence than non PP students
