Hi Diane,

Our Senate reassigned time is a line item in the budget book and is not in our faculty union contract. Each college (Mission and West Valley) gets 0.800 per semester, or a total of 1.6 per year. We also get a \$5000 stipend each year to compensate the Senate President for work during the summer months. At Mission, the Senate President gets 0.500 per semester, and the remaining 0.300 is assigned to Curriculum. We give our Curriculum Chair 0.200 and the Curriculum Tech Review Chair 0.100. Not much, but because we can't negotiate it we are pretty much stuck. On occasion our Office of Instruction supplements the Curriculum reassigned time, but it's not a given and often doesn't happen. I hope you folks are in better shape!
