With reaffirmation, our midterm report will be due in Fall 2019. The midterm report will need to cover all Action Plans from the ISER and any Visiting Team Recommendations for improvement from the Fall 2015 visit.

During 2017-18, the committee will send out the College Actions Plans from the ISER and the Visiting Team Recommendations to appropriate committees, workgroups, and individuals. We will follow up with the progress on the recommendations and actions plans during the year The committee mapped all College Actions Plans and the Visiting Team Recommendations to the new standards to assist in preparing the midterm report for Fall 2019.

The committee has also started assigning standards to relevant committees, offices, and individuals in preparation for the next ISER.

Standards I and II have been mapped but the committee still needs to look over assigning Standards III and IV to appropriate groups. During Spring 2018 or Fall 2018, the steering committee will begin sending out standards to relevant groups to begin examining how their work might fit with the Accreditation Standards.
