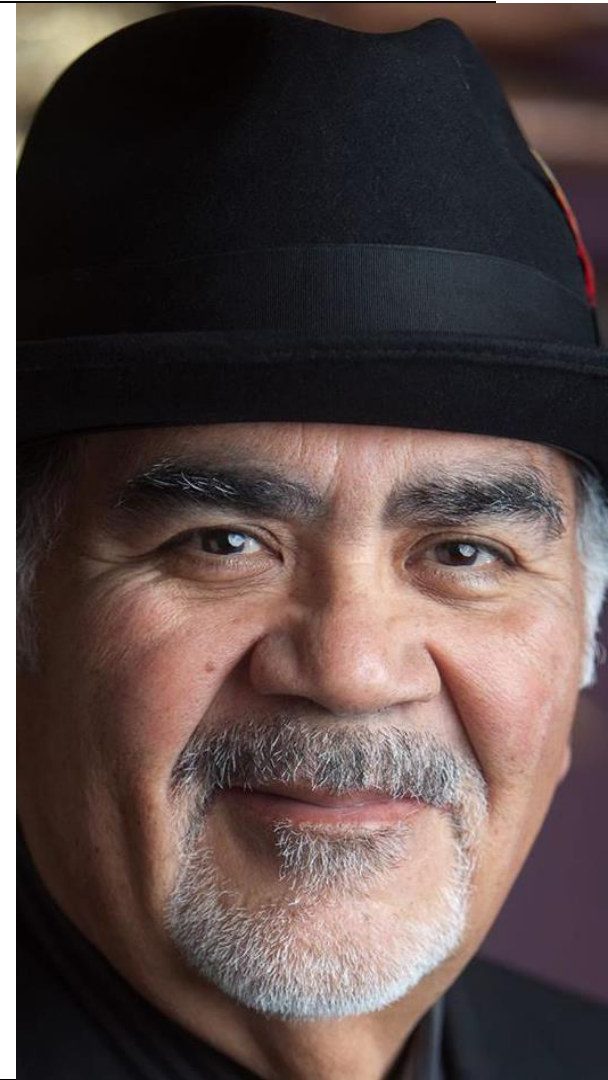
Bobby Lee Verdugo
