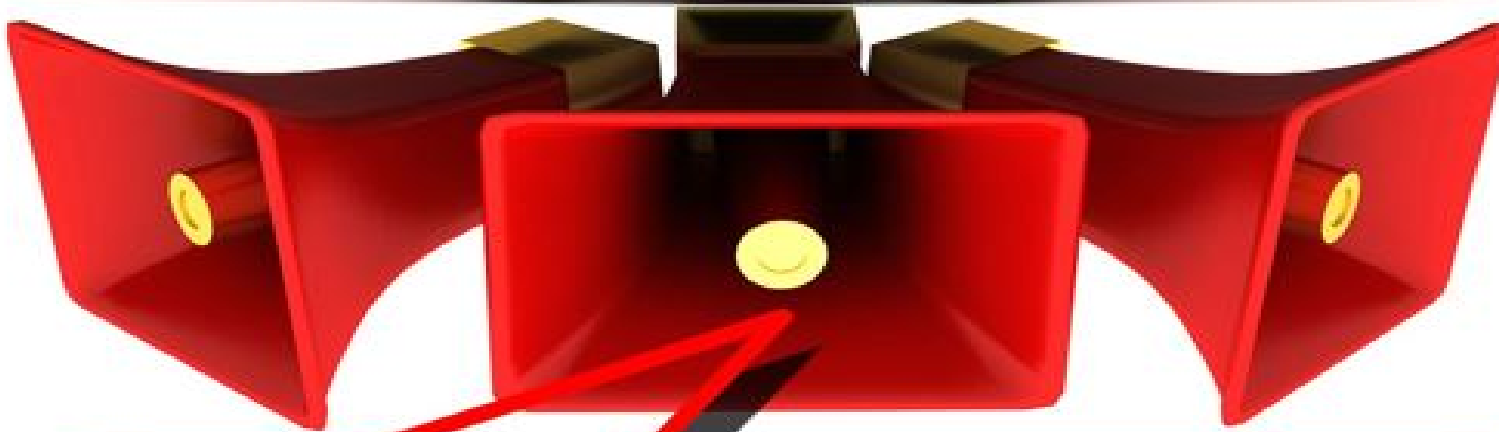

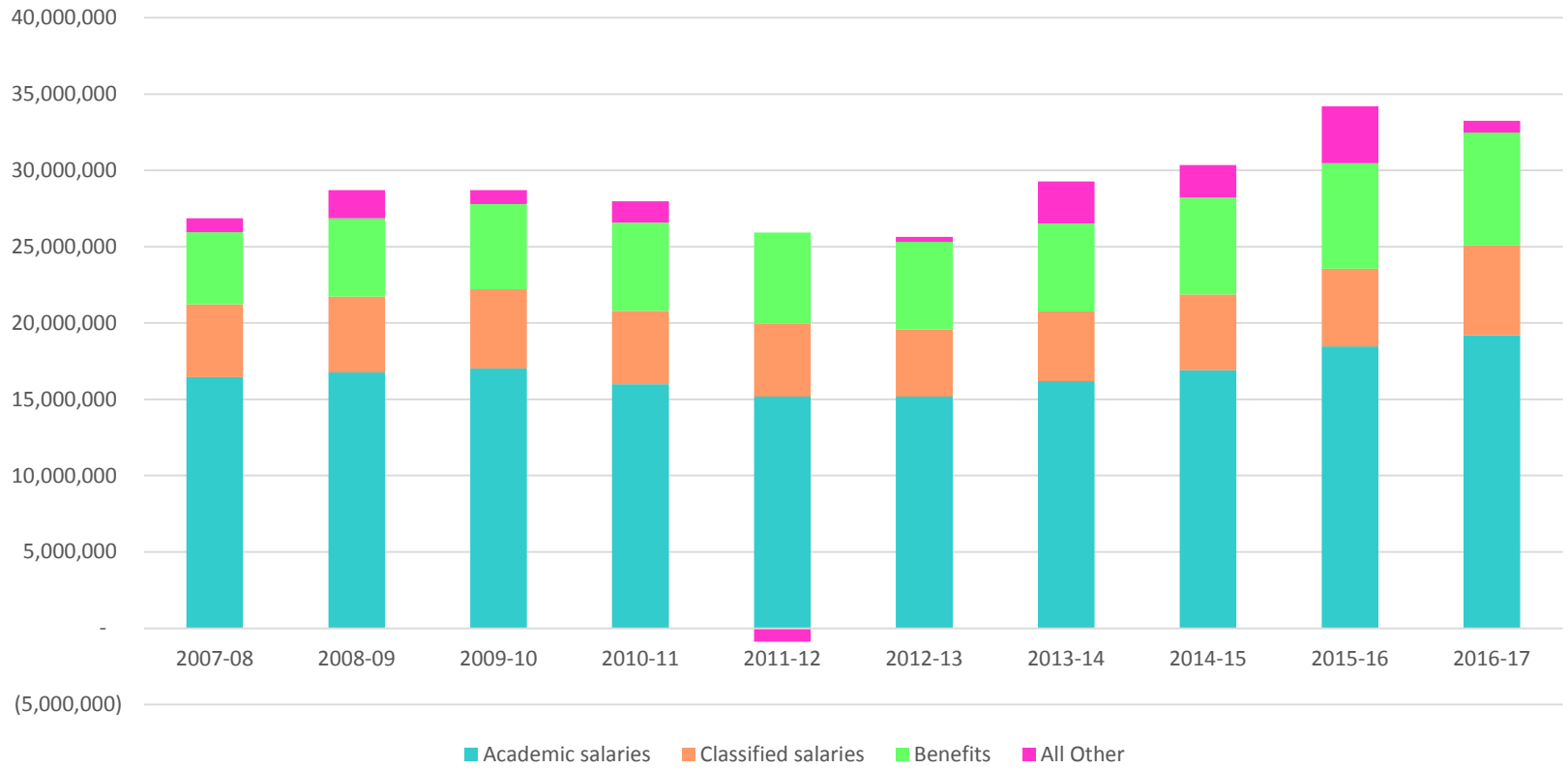

Legislative Analyst's Office (LAO)

Analysis of Governor's 2017-18 Budget

- Predicts higher Proposition 98 minimum guarantee, estimated to be up to \$150 million for community colleges
- Recommends a larger base augmentation if additional state revenue is available in May
- Recommends close monitoring of college course offerings to ensure colleges do not unduly expand enrollment in nonpriority areas to meet enrollment targets
