

- Do not need to attend or work at Las Positas College to enroll
- Child with an IEP regardless of income— part day only

Dave Maurer offers a wealth of experience as both a career military officer and a senior leader within the private sector. His corporate leadership pedigree includes service as Executive Vice President and Director for several firms in the Washington, D.C. Metro area. Among other career achievements, he led the nation's largest career transition training program spanning all 50 states, 15 countries and 2 U.S. territories in support of the Labor Department and the U.S. military training over 1.3 million service members and spouses

Dave was commissioned in the Army and served in a wide variety of command and staff positions in the United States and overseas throughout his 22-year military career. His service included tours within the intelligence community and on the Joint Staff in the Pentagon; and culminated as the Adjutant General for the United States Military Academy at West Point.
