- Chabot has savings from 13 positions that were not filled
- The balance does include any possible retirements who would not be taken off the rolls until they leave
- Reductions were made to the transfers outs due to the reduced need to transfer into the Child Development Fund
- A contribution will still be made but at a lower rate

- Another area cut was the adjuncts budget including benefits by about \$500,000.00 total
