  - **ECE 61: Literature for the Young Child & ECE 78: Language Development** These are important courses for teachers in the classroom and topics that our National Association for the Education of Young Children believes all early childhood teachers should understand. (<https://www.naeyc.org/our-work/families/everyday-steps-reading-and-writing>) and is one of the CA Early Childhood Competency areas for supporting Dual Language Learners “Language and literacy development are essential and foundational for development and learning.” (CA Early Childhood Competencies, p. 45). The two courses are currently electives, which is why we are having issues with low enrollments. This year, Spring, we plan to put together a new certificate on Curriculum that we tentatively plan to have ECE 61, ECE 78 and ECE 42 (Early Childhood Math and Science) and ECE 64 (Play and Play Materials). We believe adding this new certificate will be a positive support to our certificates for the Associate and Teacher, as well as the new ADT in Early Elementary Education that we are building. We hope you will strongly consider not deactivating these courses to give us time to rebuild them. We will be offering ECE 61 in Fall 20 and ECE 78 in Spring 21.
  - **KIN 27: Principles of Coaching & Sports Officiating** A primary target audience of this course will be coaches, and students aspiring to a career in coaching. The working commitments of this profession are unpredictable and sporadic. Thus, to meet the needs of this target audience it is important that an option for this course delivery is provided through Distance Education. In years past, this course was very popular among students when taught face-to-face, and with the increased flexibility of DE, I'd expect its popularity to increase.
  - **KIN AIE: Adapted Individualized Exercise** We have been trying to run adapted courses for they have been taken off the schedule for low enrollment. We want to provide adaptive courses and saving these helps us attempt to capture the students who would be interested in taking these courses. This particular course serves those who are otherwise not able to participate in a mainstreamed activities course. We are looking to offer this course for Fall 2020 or Spring 2021. This course may be our option for the need for an adaptive course, we will be able to direct the course to the individuals enrolled and to cater to their specific limitations and emphasize the conditions for improvement.
  - **KIN AAQE: Adapted Aquatic Exercise** We have been trying to run adapted courses for they have been taken off the schedule for low enrollment. We want to provide adaptive courses and saving these helps us attempt to capture the students who would be interested in taking these courses. This particular course serves those who are otherwise not able to participate in a mainstreamed activities course. We are looking to offer this course for Fall 2020 or Spring 2021. This course may be our option for the need for an adaptive course, we will be able to direct the course to the individuals enrolled and to cater to their specific limitations and emphasize the conditions for improvement.
  - **KIN AQA: Adapted Aquatic Exercise** We are looking at offering a fast track version of this course to run in Fall 2020 or Spring 2021. We have found that the students this course serves is sensitive to

sever weather and either would run this a late start course in the spring or an early course in the fall. The semester long version of this course has not worked out well in the past.

- **KIN LG: Lifeguarding** Lifeguarding for Spring 2021. We plan on changing the course over to online as well through curriculum, then offer it as a hybrid. The American Red Cross released a hybrid platform last spring, and it is going well. Our complication before what that it was either offered as a full term course which didn't allow students to get their certification in time for summer employment. We also tried it as a short term, but scheduling around our meets as well as trying to meet the needs of the students was too challenging for space and time in the pool. The HYBRID class is the way to go.
- **MUS 12: Wind Ensemble** Pending the available FTEF from CEMC, we plan on offering MUS 12 Wind Ensemble as a summer class. Either Summer 2020 or Summer 2021. The reason we won't offer it during Fall and Spring is that we have too many instrumental ensembles, and they will eat into each other's enrollments. A summer offering is perfect as we can hopefully use it as a recruiting tool and get HS students to take it.
- **PHTO 69: Intermediate Videography** The plan is to offer PHTO 69 Intermediate Videography Fall 2020 Semester. In addition to PHTO 69 being a part of our new Photography AA and Certificate of Achievement the cast is also an elective in the upcoming proposed Film Studies A.A.
- **THEA 11: Stage to Screen** As this course will be offered in the film degree, I will need to meet with Elizabeth to check on her intended offering of other courses so we can make it work with students completing that degree. As that degree will offer for the first time in Fall 2020, she and I will begin planning course schedule this Fall, when we begin looking at discipline plans for next year. I will be sure to have a plan by then. We will get a plan to you soon.
- **CSU-GE/IGETC for AA/AS – Presented by Craig Kutil**- This will allow students to get local degrees using CSU GE or IGETC, which have much higher unit requirements. IGETC does not require health and wellness or American cultures so this will have impacts on those departments. The catalog will need to be update for all of our local programs to reflect this change. This will move forward for voting.
