7.1. Catalog Rights

- Conversation starting with Chabot's Curriculum Committee and faculty regarding Catalog Rights.
- Current procedure with LPC is that if a student starts classes during one academic year (Fall to Summer), then misses classes for another academic year, they will lose catalog rights from when they started.
- Chabot is proposing for something district-wide; catalog rights will be extended from when a student started within the district and attends any higher education institution, then returns to CLPCCD.
- CK and CL pointed out issues regarding LPC's evaluator's and their process/workload. Only two evaluators responsible for ADT evaluation, graduation applications, transfer articulation, etc., the addition of extending catalog rights would definitely contribute to their workload.

- If a process is established, for example, a form and mandatory meeting with a counselor, to assist evaluators could be useful for evaluators moving forward if the extension of catalog rights is approved.
