

CCP 1050 CREDIT FOR PRIOR LEARNING CRITERIA

Courses require approval of the Curriculum Committee to allow students to earn course credit through Credit for Prior Learning (CPL). The specific criteria for approving courses for each method of CPL are outlined below:

Credit by Exam

There are no specific criteria required to request credit by exam. ~~but a~~ An ~~department-wide~~ examination that measures a student's competency in ~~both~~ the Course ~~course~~ Content ~~content~~ and Course Outcomes ~~shall be developed and assessed by the appropriate discipline faculty.~~ is required for the assessment and must be checked for bias.

Credit by ~~Portfolio~~ Authenticated Competencies

The specific ~~elements~~ evidence ~~of the Portfolio~~ students are expected to submit must be identified to request credit by portfolio. ~~and the course must have P/NP as a grading option.~~

Credit by Industry Recognized Certifications and Documented Training
~~Recognized Training~~

The specific certification/licensure/credential/coursework, required recency, and issuing agency are required. Unless letter grades can be determined for the training, the course must have P/NP as a grading option.

Credit ~~by~~ for Military ~~JST~~ Service/Training

There are no specific criteria required to request credit ~~by~~ for military ~~JST~~ service/training, but the course must have P/NP as a grading option.
