

STUDENT TEXTBOOK SURVEY

Due to the cost of textbooks:

| Take fewer classes | 31% |
|---|-----|
| Do not register for a specific course | 27% |
| Drop or withdraw from a course | 16% |
| Not purchase textbook | 40% |
| Purchase books elsewhere | 76% |

Cost of textbooks is higher than the cost of tuition

WHAT ARE OPEN EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES?

Open Educational Resources (OERs) are teaching, learning, and research resources released under <u>an open</u> <u>license that permits their free use and repurposing by others.</u> OERs can be textbooks, full courses, lesson plans, videos, tests, software, or any other tool, material, or technique that supports access to knowledge.

Textbooks that are **free** to: Download, Print & Keep Copy & Share, adapt, Modify, Remix.

- Can customize to suit your class
- Opportunities for collaboration
 - Curating a book with others
 - Adding resources to what's available
- Students have access to the book right away
- Students can keep it forever



Online Educational Resources (OER) SB 1359


SB 1359 requires that all courses that offer zero-cost digital textbooks or course materials are properly identified in our online class schedule. This new requirement is mandated for all OER courses beginning in January 2018.





Cost of Course Materials






