To the College Instructional Technology Committees:

I coordinate the CARE (Chabot-Las Positas Association of Retired Employees) <u>Special Grants Program</u>, which each year provides small grants to faculty and staff for special projects. I am writing to alert your committees to the following pattern of grant requests that may reflect a need that should be evaluated at an institutional level.

For the last three successive years, applicants from one or both colleges have sought grant funds to purchase Texas Instruments TI-84 graphing calculators. The requests have originated from particular individuals, centers, or campus units.

Following are examples of these proposals:

- Increasing Student Access to Graphing Calculators
- HSI Gateway to Success Calculator Loaner Program
- Loaner Graphing Calculators
- Excelerated Math Program Purchase TI84 Calculators (proposal late not funded)

The CARE Special Grants are intended for start-up costs of pilot projects, but not for ongoing operational costs, so the CARE grants evaluation committee is unlikely to continue funding such isolated requests in the future.
