- Training and Hiring Needs
  - Turf grass (synthetic) students are interested, but may be outlawed, top seller, not loved by industry
  - o Green infrastructure (Soils or landscape maintenance)
  - o Bio-swell (made up of sand, frequent watering until established)
  - o Reclaimed water (expensive to bring a meter to new location, capacity issue)
- Emerging Trends
  - o CLCA presentation on electrical equipment
  - o Electric Mower, like rhumba
  - Solar fields
  - Handheld moisture sensors
- Internship Opportunities
  - Allied Landscape no internships
  - Alden Lane not hiring
  - What does an internship look like? Expose students to cool projects, business functions, around
