3. Industry Update

Yoko Oda reported that inflation is a major concern as she cannot get an accurate prediction of her pipeline and is predicting 2023 to be flat. High Point in Las Vegas is happening, with lots of designers attending. A little concerned about sourcing from the east coast right now.

Rita Lezama's clients are looking to do projects. Size-wise, the projects haven't changed. She is seeing issues with appliances. Working with local cabinet shops, and it's going well. Have been on track with projects.

Kelly Tivey is experiencing similar but with ETAs improving but seeing delays on appliances and some plumbing fixtures. Trades are more available.

Experiencing a total slowdown in inquiries. Not much in the pipeline.

Michelle Webber's classes are going well. Noticing the kids are less creative and a little needy but doing the work.

Helena Cruz, we are experiencing a decline in enrollment, but we have many more students on campus this semester and many more activities. CTE Outreach is getting more invitations to do presentations in high schools. Employers are finding it difficult to find people to fill jobs.
