CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT INFORMATION FORM

Las Positas College offers Concurrent Enrollment for F-1 students who are maintaining their full-time enrollment status at other schools **OR** who are taking a full-time course load by taking a class or more at Las Positas College to complement their enrollment at their host school.

F-1 students from other schools who wish to take on-campus or online classes at Las Positas College part-time or over the summer must follow these steps:

- 1. Complete the Las Positas College standard application through CCC Apply at: https://secure.cccapply.org/applications/CCCApply/apply/Las_Positas_College.html
- 2. Submit a copy of the following Immigration documents to the International Student Program (ISP) Office in Building 1600 Second Floor):
 - a. page 1 of your current I-20 from the school you are currently attending,
 - b. your passport biographic page,
 - c. your visa page, and
 - d. your Form I-94 Arrival Record.
- 3. You may register for classes online after the registration date that applies to you. Registration for New Students taking a Summer or Fall 2015 term course begins on May 18, 2015.
- 4. Before registering for Mathematics, English, ESL, or Chemistry courses, you must take an Assessment test. You can make an appointment for an Assessment test online at: http://www.laspositascollege.edu/assessmentcenter/index.php. For questions about prerequisite clearance, please contact our Counseling Office (Building 1600 First floor).
- 5. Submit proof of your Tuberculosis (TB) Test within 2 weeks from the start of the semester. This test must be performed within one year. You can take this test our Student Health and Wellness Center (Building 1700) during the Spring or Fall semesters. The Student Health and Wellness Center is not open during the Summer Session. A TB test is not required to for students taking only online classes.
