If I had any advice, it would be to weigh your options before enrolling in a HyFlex class and evaluate what you, as a student, need. Make sure it sounds right to you and be confident that a class like that would work best with your preferred teaching style. Again, HyFlex isn't an inherently bad idea; it just isn't for me, personally.

I would say	

that only take Hyflex classes if you are planning to come in-person because it can be useful when you are unable to come to class. If you expect to go fully online be prepared for a lot of technical issues and bad microphone and video quality. If you don't have a mic, don't take a Hyflex class because most professors ignore the chat and leave questions unanswered.
